Until September 2, visitors to LongHouse Reserve will be able to regenerate while enjoying over one hundred chairs, sofas, poufs, tables, and parasols by Paola Lenti, admiring their textile coverings, structural weavings, and exclusive colours.

In the spaces of LongHouse Reserve, Paola Lenti's collections express their authentic value because it is precisely from nature that the brand draws inspiration to create its designs, colours, fabrics, and materials.

Displayed in five different areas, spread over a total surface of 12,000 hectares, the products, discreetly integrated into the natural context, define living environments recognizable for their craftsmanship, the presence of natural woods, original textures, unprecedented colours, as well as weather-resistant, durable, and sustainable fabrics.

In the Pavilion and Breezeway Area, the neutral and natural colours of the Kaba, Orlando, Harbour, and Vespucci sofas dialogue with the orange-burgundy tones of the Telar armchairs and the Maglia Rasata cushions, echoing the essences chosen for the Giro table tops.

On the terrace located on the first floor of the modernist building that housed Jack Lenor Larsen's residence, the Ami armchairs, Tobit poufs, and Giro and Strap tables separate two perfectly symmetrical dining areas. Around the Sunset tables, the weavings of the Telar chairs become pleasing notes in turquoise green.

Outside, Paola Lenti products help create informal and convivial living environments immersed in greenery. The Otto poufs and Telar armchairs in green tones allow enjoying the view of the pool in front of the house entrance, while on the lawn surrounding the large and evocative pond, the Telar armchairs dot the natural scenery with vibrant accents of yellow, lime, fuchsia, and orange.

Finally, under the Fly's Eye Dome, the architectural sculpture designed by Buckminster Fuller, the Otto poufs, in various shapes and sizes, punctuate the lawn with brilliant shades of green.

Thanks to the collaboration with the partner West | Out East in the Hamptons, Paola Lenti, together with LongHouse Reserve, guides every visitor through gardens, furnishings, and sculptures on a journey of discovery and contemplation of the surrounding beauty generated by the union of art and nature.
